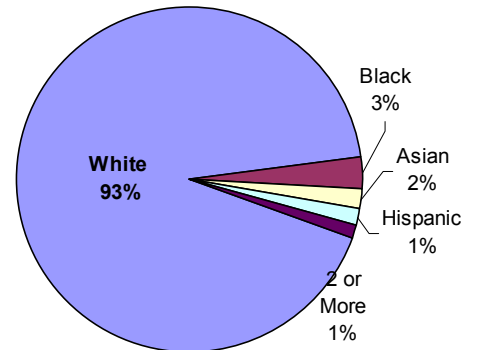
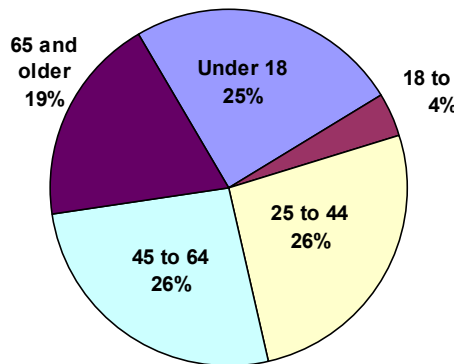

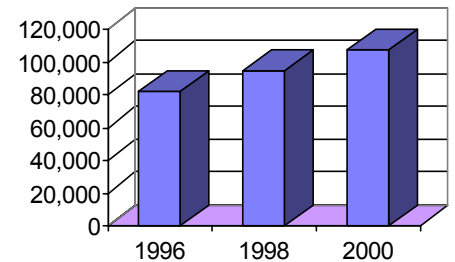

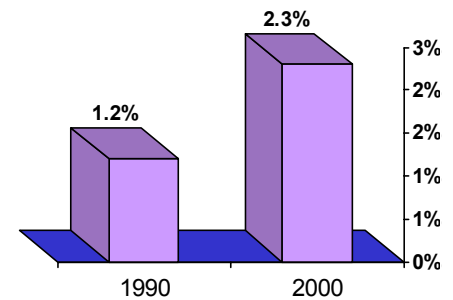

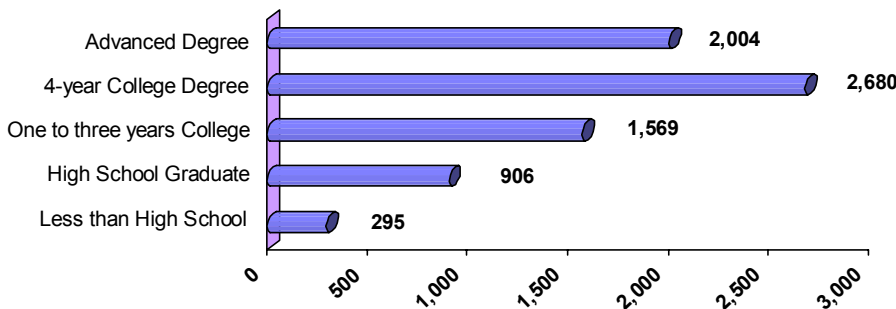

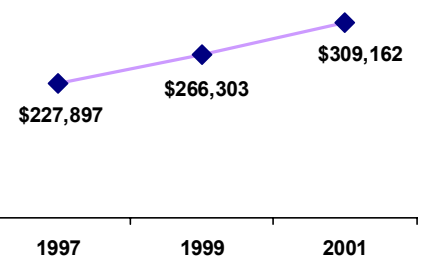
Change in Poverty
