Our first step back on the stage will be to support working parents during the school mid-winter break and allow area youth to create and learn about the performing arts. Interested students will come from the Pontiac school system, as well as area schools in Oakland County. The outcome - students will be performing an entirely produced musical during the week of April 23, 2022.
